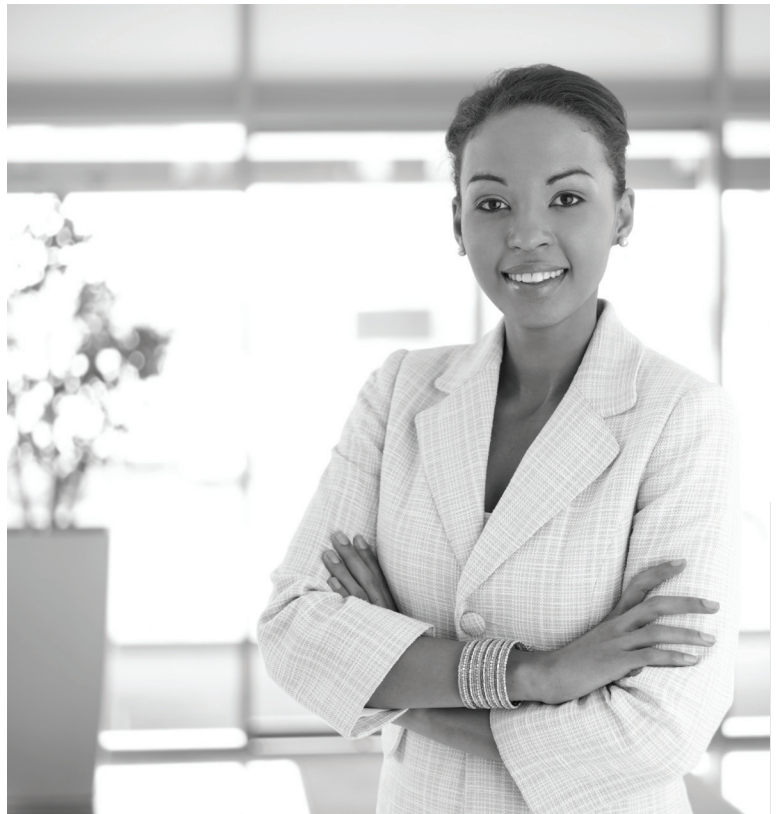

The Leadership Accelerator Program

Led by a world-class multidisciplinary faculty and business leaders, this two-day program provides leaders with an intensive developmental experience.

Who should attend

This program is designed for managers with 2-10 years of leadership experience. Well-qualified participants are responsible for leading a team of individual contributors. Job titles may include assistant/associate directors, senior managers, project managers or managers.

The Leadership Accelerator Program focuses on five critical leadership competencies:

- **Leading Self**
- **Strategic Focus**
- **Connecting with Others**
- **Leading Others**
- **Delivering Results**

Topics covered include:

Leading self: leveraging the totality of who you are and engaging in self-reflection

Values: clearly defining the role of personal values in leadership to better understand your decision making process

Delegation: effectively delegating the appropriate decisions and tasks to the right people at the right time with proper follow-through

Communication: generating effective communication to drive optimal performance and ensure successful conversations

Developing others: providing tactful, well-timed and appropriate developmental feedback

Better decisions: understanding how your inherent biases play a role in decision making

Action planning: crafting a personal action plan for implementation upon returning to work

Valuable insight: participate in a roundtable with an industry leader

Participating in this program will help the organization:

- Build organizational capacity for managers to assume greater responsibilities.
- Develop individuals to strengthen internal talent development and drive succession plan initiatives
- Identify organizational leaders capable of building leadership capacity and engaging those they lead.
- Increase internal productivity and effectiveness.

- Build a strong understanding of awareness of self and understand how self-knowledge strengthens leadership capabilities.
- Strengthen skills to generate effective communication, drive optimal performance and ensure successful conversations.
